## **Basic Computer Training**

### Skill Development

VIN has been conducting basic computer training for children and youth from marginalized communities in Okhaldhunga. Children and young people in Okhaldhunga do not have much exposure to information and technology. Due to inaccessibility and poverty, most of them cannot afford a computer. As a result, they are always lagging behind with regards to current development.

Henceforth, realizing this desperate need to address this issue, VIN has designed a basic course for interested individuals. We have a total of 68 participants from different age groups. The classes are organized on a daily basis from early morning till evening. The participants show a great deal of interest and motivation in learning how to use a computer and internet. # **Bag Making Training**

Entrepreneurship and Skill Development

Under, Dalit Entrepreneurship Project, VIN has been conducting a 10-days long bagmaking training for 14 women from marginalized communities. They are provided soft trainings to make different kind of bags for daily use, ranging from shopping bags, carry-on bags, party bags and many more.

This training will not only polish them with an added skill but also provide an opportunity to enhance their financial standing. It gives them a sense of self-worth and independence. We have observed that the participants are very keen on learning new designs and they have been giving their best.

Later on, the participants can take the initiative to produce bags and sell in their own communities. Or, they can even cover larger markets in big cities. They may also form groups and work together producing large number of bags. These products can then be sold in larger cities like Kathmandu, Pokhara, Biratnagar etc. The possibilities are infinite. ## Beads-making training

## Entrepreneurship and Skill Development

Beads-making training is focused towards the skill development of marginalized women from Okhaldhunga, especially those from Dalit community. Women from this particular community have faced years of discrimination and are devoid of appropriate opportunities. Thus, VIN is rendering them an opportunity to develop their skills and start a small business within the comfort of their own homes.

During this 10-days training period, women learn to make beautiful beads necklace, finger-rings, bangles, ear-rings and more. They are provided with essential materials during this phase of learning and practicing Participating women seem very enthusiastic to learn the new skill handicraft skill and convert it in a source of income generation. So far, we have 14 participants for the training. After the training, they can commercially make the articles and sell it to a nearby market or bring it to Kathmandu (the capital of Nepal) for larger market coverage. We have been motivating the women to diligently participate in the training so that they can be entrepreneurs of tomorrow.

# COVID-19 Prevention Campaign

#### **Awareness Program**

COVID-19 Awareness and Capacity Building Campaign was conducted in Siddhicharan Municipality, Okhaldhunga and Tarkeswore Municipality, Kathmandu from 23rd June to 18th August, 2020. A total of 64 campaigns were conducted, maximum of 3 campaigns in a day with 25-30 participants in each session. In total 1,911 households were benefited from the campaign.

The campaign was accomplished in four segments. Initially, the model of campaign was presented to key stakeholders. Secondly, community awareness was conducted with Women Groups. Third, we donated COVID-19 prevention materials to health centers, ward offices, security offices and participants. Finally, women group members were trained to make liquid hand wash for personal and commercial purpose. The session was thus conducted ensuring physical distancing and COVID-19 safety protocols.
